DECLARATION No. 2020-D01**

**A DECLARATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF
MEADOWLAKES, TEXAS, DECLARING THAT COVID-19
POSES AN IMMINENT THREAT OF DISASTER IN THE
CITY AND DECLARING A STATE OF DISASTER IN THE
CITY OF MEADOWLAKES, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Meadowlakes on the 20th day of March 2020, has determined that there is an imminent threat of injury or loss of life or property resulting from the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has been recognized globally as a contagious respiratory virus: and

WHEREAS, it is critical to take additional steps to prepare for, respond to, and mitigate the spread of COVID-19 to protect the health and welfare of the City of Meadowlakes; and

WHEREAS, declaring a state of disaster will facilitate and expedite the use and deployment of resources to enhance preparedness and response; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Texas certified that COVID-19 poses an imminent threat of disaster and declared a state of disaster for all counties in the State of Texas on the 13th day of March 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of City of Meadowlakes has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate and prevent the suffering of people and to protect property; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, BY THE MAYOR OF
MEADOWLAKES:**

Section 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Meadowlakes.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.

Section 5. This proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
