§ 91.01 NOTICE REQUIRED.

(A) Before the excavation of any street in the city, any utility company or any other party shall first give notice of the intention to excavate or disturb the surface of the street. Same notice shall be given to the Building Committee. This requirement is for the purpose of aiding motorist safety.

(B) Save and except, in the event of an emergency, the Meadowlakes Utility District need not give notice prior to the excavation of the street, but may proceed without giving the required notice. The Utility District shall give notice of the excavation as soon as practical thereafter. (Ord. 92-9-12, passed 9-12-92; Am. Ord. 2006-29, passed 11-7-06) Penalty, see § 91.99

§ 91.02 PAVEMENT REPAIR.

The pavement and the subsurface of the street shall be repaired in the manner consistent with and using the specifications as provided by the Building Committee.
